Prayer in this second petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.77 dated 2.3.2019 registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 324, 354-D IPC, 1860 and (Section 326 and 12 of POSCO Act, 2005 added later on), at Police Station Sector-31, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that earlier petition filed by the petitioner was dismissed as withdrawn. He further states that co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Pappu has been admitted on bail by this Court in CRM-M-28378 of 2019 (Pappu versus State of U.T. Chandigarh), decided on 11.07.2019. Petitioner is in custody since 28.05.2019.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the fact the co-accused of the petitioner has been admitted on bail.

In view of the fact that co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Pappu has been admitted on bail and case of the petitioner is at par with that

regular bail, subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
