Prayer in the present petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in a criminal case arising from FIR No.508 dated 09.09.2016 registered under Sections 148, 149, 201, 216, 302, 323, 307, 427, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Sadar Thanesar, District Kurukshetra.

As per case of the prosecution in the FIR, Rajender Singh had fired from his pistol and killed Hardeep.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Jeet Singh, has submitted that later on police found that the bullet which killed Hardeep has been fired by Jitender Malik, therefore, offence under Section 302 IPC was deleted against the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that 7 co-

accused persons namely Ankush @ Thusa, Goldy @ Gurjit Singh, Manish, Vishal, Sachin @ Chinu, Manish @ Mannu and Sahil have been granted the concession of regular bail.

Learned counsel for the State admits that till date, pistol recovered from Rajender Singh has not been sent for expert examination. Anil, second petitioner, has not been named in the FIR.

Investigations are complete. Police report as required under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been filed. Charges are yet to be framed and now the case is fixed for appearance of the accused.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the aforesaid facts and the fact that conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioners are directed to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
