Petitioner-husband has filed the present revision petition impugning the order dated 17.08.2019 passed by the learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Rewari, whereby on an application filed by the respondent under Section 125 Cr.P.C. for interim maintenance, the learned Family Court has awarded interim maintenance @ Rs.7,000/- per month from the date of application, with a further direction that this amount shall be adjustable if the maintenance is granted in any of the other proceedings between the parties.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has passed his +2 examination and thereafter, he was working as a Guest Teacher with Gurukul English Institute, Mohindergarh, but now his services have been terminated from that school. He is not running any mobile shop at Mohindergarh, as projected by the respondent. Apart from that the petitioner is required to maintain his old mother and three younger sisters and a

younger brother. Counsel has also stated that the petitioner is ready to settle the dispute with the wife.

I have heard counsel for the petitioner.

Though the respondent has pleaded that the petitioner is working as a Teacher in Gurukul English Institute at Mohindergarh and is running a mobile shop and earning Rs.40,000/- per month, but without making any observation as regard his income, and considering the fact that the respondent is the wife of the petitioner and the interim maintenance is Rs.7,000/- per month, this Court finds that the awarded maintenance is not on higher side.

No ground for interference is thus made out.

Dismissed.

As regard the argument of the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is ready to settle the dispute with the wife, the petitioner is at liberty to make such submission before the learned Family Court where the dispute is pending between the parties.
