The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 0078 dated 16.07.2019, under Sections 324, 323 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' - for short) (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Kot Kapura, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is a delay of two days in lodging the FIR. He also contends that the occurrence took place at 05:30 p.m. on 14.07.2019 while the FIR was lodged on 16.07.2019 at 07:30 p.m.

Heard.

It is manifest from the FIR that the petitioner, who was armed with a 'kapa', had caused injury on the skull of the complainant. On medical examination, it was found to be a fracture on the frontal bone left side of the skull. In view of the petitioner having caused a serious injury on the head of the complainant with a 'kapa' which resulted in the fracture of the skull,

I do not deem it to be a fit case to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
