Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.42 dated 06.04.2019 registered under Section 498-A of IPC (Section 406 of IPC added lateron) at Police Station City 2 Mansa, District Mansa.

Petitioner is mother-in-law of respondent No.2-Kamalpreet Kaur. Vide order dated 14.10.2019, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Accordingly, the parties have appeared before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court where a settlement has been arrived at between them on 05.12.2019. The settlement/agreement dated 05.12.2019 entered between petitioner and respondent No.2 is made part of the record.

The petitioner has handed a draft of Rs.1,25,000/- in the name of respondent No.2 in terms of the settlement.

In view of the fact that the matter has been resolved between the parties, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 14.10.2019 whereby the arrest of the petitioner was stayed, is hereby made absolute.

However, in case the petitioner is required in the case in any manner, a clear 15 days notice shall be given to her.

The parties shall adhere to the terms of settlement in letter and spirits.
