ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.0023 dated 30.06.2019 under Section 307 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1969, registered at Police Station GRP, Patiala, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is a counter blast to the FIR registered by the petitioner wherein he had received injuries on 25.06.2019 and had registered an FIR No.81 dated 25.06.2019 in this regard.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 14.10.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Balbir Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 14.10.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
