Prayer in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C., is for seeking a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for releasing the detainee namely Balraj Singh, son of the petitioner, who has been illegally confined by respondent No.3.

As per the report of the Warrant Officer, he visited the Police Station CIA-II, Tarn Taran for release of the detainee namely Balraj Singh, however, he was not found there.

Reply by way of affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police (Investigation) District Tarn Taran is filed in the Court, which is also to the same effect that the detainee is not involved in any other case and therefore, he was never arrested or illegally detained by the police.

Counsel for the petitioner did not dispute that the detainee has returned back to home.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous.
