This is an application under Order 22 Rule 3 CPC for bringing on record the legal representatives of deceased-appellant – Gurbachan Singh.

It has been averred in the application that during the pendency of the writ petition, appellant had died on 15.11.2018, leaving behind his legal representatives (daughters & sons) as mentioned in Para No. 2 of the application. The application is accompanied by an affidavit of Sh. Gurdev Singh, who is the son of deceased-appellant.

After hearing learned counsel for the applicant-appellant and perusing the contents of the application, which is supported by an affidavit, the same is allowed, subject to all just exceptions and the applicants, as mentioned in Para 2 of the application are ordered to be impleaded as legal representatives of deceased appellant – Gurbachan Singh. It is, however, clarified that this order shall not confer any title upon the legal representatives to the estate of the deceased appellant – Gurbachan Singh

and this order has been passed only to allow the aforesaid legal

representatives to pursue this appeal.

The amended Memo of Parties filed along with the application is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

CM stands disposed of accordingly.
