On 07.10.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for pre-arrest bail in FIR No.108 dated 7.9.2019 registered under Sections 306, 34 IPC at Police Station City II, Malerkotla, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner apart from referring to order passed on 3.10.2019 in CRM M-42436-2019 with respect to a co-accused has submitted that even from the reading of FIR, offence under Section 107 IPC read with Section 306 IPC is not made out.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupinder Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab and seeks time to get instructions.

Let a copy of the petition be supplied to the learned State counsel during the course of the day.

List alongwith CRM-M-42436-2019 on 22.11.2019.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Daljit Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, order dated 07.10.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
