Present petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, challenges the order dated 12.07.2019 (Annexure P-13) whereby the petitioner has been transferred from one station in Ludhiana i.e. Civil Veterinary Dispensary, Butahri to Buffalo Farm Mattewara, Ludhiana.

Admittedly, petitioner continues to stay at Ludhiana and therefore, cannot claim that he has been transferred from one station to another and has suffered displacement. It is settled principle that transfer orders are not to be interfered under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, in the absence of mala fides etc. Accordingly, finding no merit in the present writ petition, the same is, hereby, dismissed.
