The complaint was received in the Secretariat of Hon'ble the Chief Justice, which has been registered as Criminal Writ Petition. The complainant Vishal Dahiya S/o Ramesh Chand S/o Ajit Singh R/o Village Nahri, Tehsil and District Sonipat, has alleged that on 27.09.2019 at about 7.00 P.M. his brother Vikas Dahiya @ Vikki had been picked up by the police and his whereabouts are not known since then.

The State was asked to file a status report.

Status report has been filed by Harinder Kumar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sonipat, wherein it is stated that on 12.10.2019, ASI Hari OM visited village Nahri and met the complainant – Vishal Dahiya, Ashok, Parvinder and Samunder and the alleged detainee was present there. On enquiry, it was disclosed that on 27.09.2019, police officials of CIA Staff-2 had come to the village for making enquiries with regard to sale of illegal liquor. After making enquiry from Vikas @ Vikky

(the alleged detainee), Ashok and Parvinder, they were set free. Thereafter, all above three went to Shimla without informing their family members. Meanwhile, the petitioner has filed the instant complaint alleging that Vikas @ Vikky had been illegally detained. The statements of Ashok, Parvinder and Samunder and the complainant have been annexed with status report, wherein it has been stated that complaint was made on account of misunderstanding and the alleged detainee Vikas @ Vikky was released by the CIA staff, who is present in the village.

In view of the above, no further directions are required to be issued in the matter.

Petition stands disposed of.
