In the present petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek directions to provide protection to the life and liberty from the private respondents No. 4 & 5, who are relatives of petitioner No.1, on account of their marriage which has taken place on 04.10.2019 as per Sikh Rites and Rituals in Gurudwara Dashmesh Pita Patshai Dasvi (Regd.) at village Singa Devi, Tehsil Kharar, District SAS Nagar, Mohali. The marriage certificate and photographs of the marriage have been appended as Annexures P-3 and P-4, respectively.

The petitioners are stated to be major, as the year of birth of petitioner No.1 as per Aadhaar Card (Annexure P-1) is 1999 and the date of birth of petitioner No.2 is 17.07.1993 as per Aadhaar Card (Annexure P-2).

A representation dated 04.10.2019 (Annexure P-5) has also been filed with respondent No.2.

After hearing counsel for the petitioners, without commenting upon the validity/legality of the marriage or the age of the petitioners and in view of the binding precedent of the **Hon'ble Apex Court in Lata Singh Vs. State of U.P. and another 2006(2) SCC (Criminal) 478**, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2 to look into the above said representation filed by the petitioners and take appropriate action in accordance with law and provide protection, if so required.
