Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petitioner was a signatory to a representation of employees to the House Allotment Committee, Chandigarh. They had been allotted government accommodation in Chandigarh under the out-of-turn quota vide different allotment letters, the petitioner being a beneficiary. Her request has not been acceded to by the administration for paucity of houses. Instead of making allotment to the out-of-turn allottees, the U.T., Administration invited applications for out-of-turn allotment in the year 2019 and while the petitioners are still waiting for possession of Government houses allotted to them in Chandigarh. The list will get expanded.

Counsel cites the case of one Balwinder Singh, who had approached this Court on a similar issue in *CWP No.28979 of 2019* titled *Balwinder Singh Vs. Union Territory Chandigarh and others*, which was disposed of on 04.10.2019 with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner therein in a time bound

manner by passing a speaking order. The date in that case was fixed as 03.09.2019 and is pending. Mr. Dhanda prays that this petition may be disposed of in the same terms.

His request is found reasonable since there is already an order containing the direction prayed for.

Accordingly, this petition is allowed in the same terms with the direction to the respondents to decide the representation together with the application of Balwinder Singh and others, who have approached the Administration. All these requests be decided at one go.
