The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.140, dated 14.06.2019, under Section 379-B IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.6, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he is alleged to have snatched a mobile phone. He also contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other case and is in custody for over four months. He further contends that similarly situated co-accused, namely, Sandeep Singh has been granted regular bail by this Court in CRM-M-34007 of 2019 on 01.10.2019.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Santokh Singh, states that although investigation has been completed but charges are yet to be framed.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for over four months, he is not involved in any other case, similarly situated co-accused has been granted regular bail and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take sometime, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
