ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.37 dated 10.04.2019, under Sections 323 and 307 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Nehianwala, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been attributed a single blow with wooden stick (Tamba) on the head of the complainant. The complainant has fully recovered from the injury. The petitioner is in custody for over 8 months and not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from HC Gambhur, states that 11 out of 12 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 8 months, he is not involved in any other case and has been attributed a single

blow, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
