On being pointed out as to why, petitioner has not appeared before the Executing Court and pointed out that the revision petition against the award, which is sought to be executed in the execution application, is still pending before the Registrar, learned counsel for the petitioner requests that he be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to approach the Executing Court pointing out the difficulties, which are being faced by the petitioner in respect of the decision of his revision petition, which is pending before the Registrar against the award sought to be executed.

This Court is of the view that in case the petitioner will bring to the notice of the Executing Court the difficulties, which are being pointed out in the present writ petition, the Executing Court will consider the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Keeping in view the above, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to approach the Executing Court for the redressal of the grievance of the petitioner.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty as prayed for.
