The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.457 dated 21.6.2019, under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Model Town Panipat, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that co-accused, Jaswinder had raised false insurance claim for a theft of his vehicle and the petitioner has been arraigned as co accused as he was found in possession of the said vehicle. However, the said vehicle was purchased by him from Harinderpal for due consideration and the petitioner was not aware of the fact that the vehicle was stolen. He is in custody for over 4-1/2 months and is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI-Surinder Kumar states that although challan has been filed but charges are yet to be framed.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the

petitioner, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 4-1/2 months

and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
