Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439(2) read with Section 482 Cr.PC is for cancellation of regular bail granted to respondents No.2 to 4 vide order dated 02.09.2019 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Kapurthala in FIR No.86 dated 14.08.2019 under Sections 323, 354, 307, 427 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC, Sections 24 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 as well as Sections 3 and 4 of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 registered at Police Station Sadar Phagwara, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner-complainant states that after getting bail in the aforesaid FIR, respondents No.2 to 4 are extending threat to the petitioner for which he has submitted a complaint dated 26.09.2019 (Annexure P-3) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala and at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the

Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala to take note of the said complaint.

Notice of motion to respondent No.1 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Saurav Khurana, D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Heard.

Lest it may prejudice the interest of the parties, without observing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala to look into the contents of complaint (Annexure P-3) and to act in accordance with law.
