Pursuant to the order dated 05.11.2019, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh, who is present in Court to assist him, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required presently.

In view of the above, the order dated 05.11.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute on the same terms and conditions.

However, the aforesaid order will not be treated to be an observation of this court on the merits of the case, but only in view of the fact that the investigating agency itself has stated that it does not require custodial interrogation of the petitioner.

Naturally, investigation in the case would continue, wholly on the merits of the case and eventually if a report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. is submitted to the Court, arraigning anybody as an accused, the trial court

would consider the matter wholly on the basis of evidence led before it.
