In the present writ petition, the grievance which is being raised by the petitioner is that petitioner retired from service on 31.08.2018 but all the pensionary benefits for which she is entitled, have not been released to her without any valid justification though there is no impediment in the release of the same as there are no proceedings pending against the petitioner either departmental or before any competent Court of law, which would entitle the respondents to withhold the pensionary benefits of the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that part payment have only been released, details of which have been mentioned in paragraph 3 of the writ petition.

The prayer of the petitioner is for directing the respondents to immediately release all the pensionary benefits for which the petitioner is entitled.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 06.09.2019 (Annexure P-2) to respondent

No.4, which is still pending consideration with respondent No.4 and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.4 to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by her in the representation dated 06.09.2019 (Annexure P-2), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to decide the representation dated 06.09.2019 (Annexure P-2), within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits after the decision of the representation, the same should also be paid to her within three months thereafter.
