Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 602 dated 19.9.2017 registered under Section 302 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act at Police Station, DLF-II, Gurugram.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Suresh Kumar has submitted that prosecution has already recorded the evidence of 19 witnesses out of total 22 witnesses proposed to be examined. Only official from Forensic Science Laboratory is required to be examined and the case is now fixed for 11.11.2019.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court is not inclined to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner at this stage. However, learned Trial Court is requested to conclude the trial within a period of two months. State counsel is requested to ensure the presence of official from Forensic Science Laboratory on the next date of hearing i.e 11.11.2019.
