This is second petition for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No. 58 dated 28.2.2018 registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station A Division Amritsar, District Amritsar.

First petition was dismissed vide order dated 24.8.2018 which reads as under:-

“The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.58 dated 28.02.2018 registered for the offences under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC at Police Station `A'-Division, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

petitioners and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version Bhupinder Singh has given forged power of attorney to his son Amritpal Singh and got executed the sale deed of the plot of the complainant.

At the time of arguments, it has been brought to my notice that the property has been sold to Davinder Kumar.

Keeping in view the serious allegations against the present petitioners regarding forging of documents etc. and selling of plot of the complainant to Davinder Kumar and the fact that they are required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioners are entitled for the grant of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in this petition, the same is dismissed.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that co-accused of the petitioner has been granted regular bail and therefore, this Court should entertain second bail petition.

In view of the detailed order passed on 24.8.2018 while

accused, this Court finds no reason to entertain the present second petition.

Dismissed.
