Learned counsel contends that although order Annexure P/3 dated 21.06.2019 was passed in favour of the petitioner by the Chairman, Tribunal-cum-SDO, Charkhi Dadri and despite the said order not having been challenged by the respondents, the same has not been complied with despite the petitioner having submitted representation Annexure P/5 dated 17.09.2019 for implementation of order Annexure P/3 dated 21.06.2019.

2. Notice of motion. Mr. Harish Rathee, Sr. DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that he has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. Without commenting upon the merits of the case or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is

disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation Annexure P/5 dated 17.09.2019, in accordance with law after taking into account all aspects of the matter, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
