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RAVI SHANKER JHA, C.J. (ORAL)

The tender notice was issued for appointment of HTC, Sultanpur Lodhi. The petitioner also participated in the tender process. He was permitted to transport food-grains from eight storage points. The petitioner has already submitted a representation (Annexure P8) to the effect that since new lines are being laid by railways due to which the loading work at rail head has come to halt, therefore, till the loading is not resumed at rail head Sultanpur Lodhi, in the interest of FCI, he is ready to execute work from PSWC Tash Pur Godown to Malsiyan Shahkot rail head. Confronted with the situation, the FCI has again floated an e-tender for appointment of adhoc HTC, Sultanpur Lodhi.

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that he is now ready and willing to transport the food-

grains from the eight storage points as per the initial tender floated on 25.01.2018.

If it is so, it would be open to the petitioner to make a representation to the FCI which shall be considered in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of.
