In the present petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek directions to provide protection to the life and liberty from the private respondent No. 4, who is the father of petitioner No.2, on account of their marriage which has taken place on 04.10.2019 as per Sikh Rites and Ceremonies at Sri Nirankari Darbar, Sector 21, Chandigarh. The marriage certificate and photographs of the marriage have been appended as Annexures P-3 and P-4, respectively.

The petitioners are stated to be major, as the date of birth of petitioner No.1 is 08.06.1989 as per Aadhaar Card (Annexure P-1) and date of birth of petitioner No.2 is 12.03.1996 as per Voter Identity Card (Annexure P-2).

A representation dated 04.10.2019 (Annexure P-5) has also been filed with respondent No.2 in this regard.

After hearing counsel for the petitioners, without
