This writ petition was filed seeking a direction to the police authorities of the State of Punjab to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of the unofficial respondents, the relatives of petitioner No.1.

It is the case of the petitioners that they got married against the wishes of the first petitioner's family and therefore, the need for protection.

Notice of motion in this case was issued on 09.10.2019, pursuant to which the police authorities conducted an enquiry.

Mr. Ayush Sarna, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, upon instructions from SI Ajit Singh, Police Station, Zirakpur, District Mohali, states that petitioner No.1 categorically stated before the police authorities that she no longer desires any protection from her family members.

Mr. Harinder Singh, learned counsel, put in appearance on behalf of respondent Nos. 4 and 5- the uncle and aunt of petitioner No.1, and states that neither they nor the other family members have any objection to the relationship and marriage of the petitioners. The affidavit of respondent no.5 stating to this fact is placed on record, wherein respondent No.5 also stated that she has no objection to allowing of this writ petition.

However, as the unofficial respondents have gone on record expressing their lack of objection to the relationship and marriage of the petitioners and respondent No.5 has also filed an affidavit to that effect, this Court is of the opinion that no order is required to be passed in this case. The grievance of the petitioners stand settled.

In the light of the aforesaid developments, the writ petition is dismissed.
