This order of mine shall dispose of RSA Nos.6545 and 6852 of

2016 and RSA No.1846 of 2017.

Although, as per office report, legal heirs of respondent No.1(i) to (iii) and (vi) in RSA No.1846 of 2017 and legal heirs of respondent No.2(i) to (iii) and (vi) in RSA No.6852 of 2016 have been served but no one is appearing on their behalf.

Learned counsel for the appellant has pointed out that the parties have entered into a settlement in a case arising out of succession dispute. Parties have settled their all disputes and in the presence of the counsels, parties have made a statement that they shall remain bound by the aforesaid compromise.

The aforesaid compromise deed has also been filed in this Court. Since, respondents are not coming forward, therefore, there would be no use of keeping these appeals pending.

Compromise deed dated 25.01.2018 which is a certified copy of original compromise deed is filed in the Court. Same is taken on record as Mark "C".

All the aforesaid appeals are disposed of in terms of the compromise.

The compromise deed shall form part of the decree. However, since the respondents have not appeared, therefore, they are granted opportunity to move an application for recalling, if they feel aggrieved.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are disposed of, in view of the aforesaid order.
