This writ petition was filed seeking a direction to the Police Authorities of the State of Haryana to safeguard the lives and liberty of the petitioners from respondent Nos.4 to 7, the relations of the first petitioner, Shama Parveen.

When this case was taken up for hearing on 29.10.2019, this Court was informed that the petitioners are permanent residents of Uttar Pradesh and Gujarat, respectively and that neither of the petitioners had approached the police authorities to avail police protection, despite this Court permitting them to do so, vide order dated 09.10.2019. Thereupon, Mr. Arun Dulgach, learned counsel representing Mr. Virendra Rana, Advocate for the petitioners, sought time to get instructions.

When the matter was taken up for hearing on 13.11.2019, Mr.

Arun Dulgach, learned counsel representing Mr. Virendera Rana, Advocate for the petitioners, informed this Court that the petitioners were present and that they seek an adjournment to enable them to approach the concerned police authorities.

However, today, Mr. Rajesh Gaur, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, would state on instructions from ASI Amar Singh, Police Station Nuh, that the petitioners informed the concerned police authorities that they are presently residing at Ahmedabad in the State of Gujarat and do not require any protection from the police authorities of the State of Haryana.

Recording the said statement, the writ petition is dismissed.
