The writ petition was filed seeking a direction to the police authorities of the State of Punjab to provide protection to the petitioners in the light of the threat perceived by them from the unofficial respondents, the relations of the second petitioner.

Notice of motion was ordered on 9.10.2019. Pursuant thereto, Status Report dated 31.10.2019 was filed by Shri Jasbinder Singh, Punjab Police Services, Assistant Commissioner of Police (North), Jalandhar. Perusal thereof reflects that both the petitioners appeared before the said police official and submitted their affidavits stating to the effect that they no longer want police protection and do not apprehend any danger from the unofficial respondents. They further stated that they were living together happily.

In the light of the aforesaid developments, the grievance of the petitioners stands settled. The writ petition is accordingly dismissed.
