Despite the matter being passed over, there is no representation of the petitioners or their counsel.

The writ petition was filed seeking a direction to the police authorities of the State of Haryana to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners from any threat emanating from the unofficial respondents, the family members of the first petitioner.

By order dated 9.10.2019, this Court, while directing notice of motion, required the Senior Superintendent of Police, Panipat, Haryana, the second respondent, to take necessary steps to ensure that the lives and liberty of the petitioners were not jeopardised at the hands of the unofficial respondents or any one claiming through them.

While so, ASI Gulshan, Police Station Sector 13-17, Panipat, present in person, filed the status report of Mr. Satish Kumar, Haryana Police Services, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Headquarter, Panipat, wherein, he stated that an enquiry was held and the petitioners voluntarily produced separate affidavits to the effect that the unofficial respondents

and the other family members were no longer raising any objection in connection with their relationship and marriage and that they have no apprehension of threat either to their lives or their personal liberty. He also filed true copies of the affidavits produced by the petitioners and also respondents No. 4 to 6. The same are taken on record.

In the light of the aforestated developments, the grievance of the petitioners stands settled. The writ petition is accordingly dismissed.
