Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No. 7 dated 12.08.2019 registered under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC, 1860, at Police Station NRI, District Jalandhar Rural.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that deceased-Lehmber Singh, who was the husband of Hardeep Kaur, executed general power of attorney in the name of Paramjit Kaur, mother of the petitioner. Though there was a general power of attorney, yet no benefit was taken during his lifetime. He further states that his mother Paramjit Kaur was arrested and was granted regular bail. The land in dispute has already been mutated in the name of the complainant and her children.

On the instructions from ASI Bhubnesh Kumar, learned State counsel states that the arrest of the petitioner is required to investigate regarding the forged affidavit against which they have transferred the car and the scooty in their names and they have also constructed a wall in the ancestral house.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. It is ordered that in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
