Grievance of the petitioner is that petitioner is being forced to deposit the licensed weapon in the light of the impugned directions which would pose a threat to his life and liberty. Representation dated 27.9.2019 (Annexure P-4), made to the Deputy Commissioner, Sirsa-respondent No. 3, is pending consideration in this regard.

As the said authority is yet to apply its mind to the representation dated 27.9.2019 (Annexure P-4), this Court is of the opinion that no cause is made out for adjudication of the case on merits.

Petition is accordingly disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3-Deputy Commissioner, Sirsa, to take appropriate action, if so warranted, on the representation dated 27.9.2019 (Annexure P-4) made by the petitioner within a week from today.

Disposed of with aforesaid direction.
