Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.830 dated 27.09.2019, under Sections 186, 332, 353, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Karnal City, District Karnal.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 15.10.2019, passed the following order:-

“ Contends that injuries in this case are simple in nature and moreover, the complainant has suffered the same on account of the fact that he lost his balance while disconnecting the electricity connection of the petitioner.

Notice of motion for 22.11.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Contends that in terms of the above order, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from A.S.I. Suresh Kumar, has acknowledged that in terms of order dated 15.10.2019, petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, interim order dated 15.10.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It is also made clear that petitioner shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

Disposed off accordingly.
