Impugned herein is transfer order dated 09.09.2019 (Annexure P-7), whereby, the petitioner has been transferred from Amritsar to Ferozepur despite the fact that petitioner is medically de-categorized.

2. Heard and contents of the writ petition have been perused.

3. Transfer being matter of administrative exigencies, this Court generally interferes, if at all, very cautiously. Transfer is not a punishment but an essential aspect of service, particularly, on a transferable post.

4. In my opinion, in the present case, the impugned transfer order dated 09.09.2019 (Annexure P-7) does not call for any interference from this Court in exercise of its extraordinary writ jurisdiction vested under Article 226 of Constitution of India.

5. Petition is, accordingly, dismissed being devoid of any merit.
