Prayer in the writ petition is to promote him to the post of Assistant against 5 vacant posts of promotional quota from the date of elibility i.e. 01.08.2019 with all consequential benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner will be satisfied if a direction is issued to the 2nd respondent-Vice Chancellor, Indira Gandhi University, Meerpur, Rewari, to consider the representation dated 17.09.2019 (Annexure P-5) within a stipulated period.

Without going into the merits and demerits of the claim of the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to direct 2nd respondent-Vice Chancellor,

Indira Gandhi University, Meerpur, Rewari, to consider the representation dated 17.09.2019 (Annexure P-5) within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and shall pass a speaking order thereon, failing which respondent No.2 shall be liable to pay costs of ₹25,000/- to the petitioner. This condition of imposing costs is only to prevent petitioner running from pillar to post and avail remedy of contempt in case of non-compliance of directions issued by this Court.

The writ petition stands disposed of with the above direction.
