Petitioner prays for grant of bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No. 47 dated 18.2.2019 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 379-B, 506 IPC at Police Station Kheripul, Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is not named in the FIR and is in custody since 4.4.2019. He further submits that as per the supplementary statement recorded, petitioner was present at the spot and had snatched Rs.2700/- from the injured.

Investigations are complete. Police report as required under Section 173 Cr.P.C has already been filed. Conclusion of the trial is likely to take time.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in

view the aforesaid facts, it is considered appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.
