The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 18 dated 24.01.2019, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, besides Sections 82 and 83 of the Registration Act, 1908, registered at Police Station Navi Baradari, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner, who is the Lambardar of the area, are that he had identified Vijay Kumar, who had impersonated as Charanjit Singh while preparing the general power of attorney. He also contends that there is no allegation of any money having been paid to the petitioner or to any other accused and no loss was caused in any manner to the complainant, as the general power of attorney had been cancelled. He further contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other case of similar nature.

This Court, by order dated 15.10.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Hardev Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation and not required for custodial interrogation, the order dated 15.10.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
