The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.238 dated 13.12.2018 registered under Sections 323, 324, 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later) at Police Station Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur.

The operative part of the order dated 16.10.2019, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioners, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the matter stands compromised and the parties have already filed CRM-M-43763-2019 praying for quashing of the FIR, on the basis of compromise, in which notice of motion has been issued and the parties have been directed to record their statements in support of the compromise.

Notice of motion for 06.11.2019....”

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 16.10.2019, the petitioners have appeared before the Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer as well as counsel for respondent No.2, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 16.10.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
