Petitioner prays for regular bail in FIR No. 0061, dated 28.02.2019 registered under Sections 379, 411, 472, 420, 465, 467, 389 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Zirakpur, District S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali).

This is the second bail application filed by the petitioner. His first bail application was dismissed vide order dated 06.09.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that co-accused of the petitioner has been granted concession of regular bail and petitioner be also granted concession of regular bail on parity.

On the other hand, learned State counsel has produced custody affidavit that the petitioner is involved in as many as six other cases registered in the States of Punjab, Haryana and Delhi. It has also come on record that two stolen luxurious vehicles were recovered on the disclosure statement made by the petitioner.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court is not inclined to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Present petitioner is dismissed, accordingly.
