After arguing the matter at length, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he has express instructions from the petitioners not to press the present petition and that they would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Trial Court to expeditiously dispose of the respondents' application filed by them under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 CPC alongwith their suit.

Since a direction to expeditiously dispose of a stay application in which ex parte ad interim stay has been granted would not prejudice either party as also for the reason that ingress and egress of either party is involved in the litigation, the Trial Court is directed to expeditiously dispose of the application filed by the respondents under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 CPC alongwith their suit.

The present petition is disposed of in the above terms.
