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TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners who are senior citizens have approached this Court seeking a mandamus for protection of their life and liberty.

Counsel submits that the petitioners having purchased a plot admeasuring 345 Sq. yards at Satkar Vihar Colony, Focal Point, Rajpura, commenced construction thereupon. Respondent No.5, who is a serving police official resorted to obstructing the construction activity and which constrained the petitioners to even file a civil suit for permanent injunction and in an application filed under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 CPC, interim directions have been issued. Counsel urges that inspite thereof, respondent No.5 is taking undue advantage of his official position and is now threatening the petitioners of false implication. It is against such backdrop that the petitioners fear for their life and liberty.

Having heard counsel for the petitioners at length and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioners to approach respondent No.2 i.e. the Senior

Superintendent of Police, Patiala confined to the aspect of threat to their life and liberty.

In the eventuality of any such application being preferred, respondent No.2 would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and warranted in accordance with law.
