On 17.10.2019, following order was passed:-

“Petitioner prays for pre-arrest bail in FIR No. 652 dated 20.6.2019 registered under Section 174-A IPC at Police Station Jagadhri City, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is an accused in FIR No. 188 dated 8.4.2015 in which he was enlarged on bail but due to non-appearance on one particular date of hearing, bail bonds were cancelled and surety bonds were forfeited and he was declared proclaimed offender. He further draws the attention of the Court to order dated 11.9.2019 passed in CRM-M-34009-2019 and submits that the petitioner has already appeared before the Trial Court in the aforesaid case and has been enlarged on bail. He further submits that the present FIR has been registered as the petitioner was declared proclaimed offender.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Manish Bansal, DAG, Haryana who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the State of Haryana and prays for time to seek instructions.

Let a copy of the petition be supplied to the learned counsel for the State during the course of the day.

Adjourned to 16.11.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the

petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Rajinder Kumar has submitted that the petitioner in this case has joined the investigation, cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, interim order dated 17.10.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
