Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.285 dated 29.12.2015 under Section 379-B IPC, registered at Police Station Mullana, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, two young persons snatched purse of the complainant. It is further submitted that the petitioner, who is an old man aged about 82 years, was later on nominated on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner was granted the concession of regular bail on 26.05.2016, however, he absented from the Court proceedings and was declared a proclaimed offender on 18.11.2016 and later on, he again surrendered on 04.12.2018 and is in custody since then.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gian Chand,

submits that no recovery was effected from the petitioner.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioner is an old man aged about 82 years and is in custody since 04.12.2018, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Petition is disposed of.
