A perusal of the writ petition shows that the petitioner had availed the benefit of parole in July, 2019 i.e. from 02.07.2019 to 17.07.2019. Similarly, a perusal of the impugned order reveals that there is a complaint moved by Shivani Sharma, which is being enquired into and prima facie substance has been found therein and, thus, the case of the petitioner for parole has been rejected.

Keeping in view the allegations levelled in the complaint moved by Shivani Sharma and having enjoyed the benefit of parole in July, 2019, I do not think fit that the petitioner should be granted parole within such a short span of time. Accordingly, the instant petition is ordered to stand dismissed.
