Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.51 dated 03.08.2019 under Sections 323, 324, 326, 325, 379, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Dorangla, District Gurdaspur.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 16.10.2019: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, the petitioner is attributed the injury on non-vital part of the body. It is further submitted that the petitioner is a student of 10+1 and has passed his matriculation examination with high securing marks and his academic career is at stake...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the

aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Kulwinder Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 16.10.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
