The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 205 dated 16.08.2019, registered under Sections 307, 506, 148, 149 of the IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms, Act at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

The operative part of the order dated 16.10.2019, vide which the petitioners have been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though the petitioners are shown armed with sword and datar, however, neither there is any allegation that they have caused injuries to the injured nor the same is reflected in the FIR.

List again on 31.10.2019.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 16.10.2019, have already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Charanjit Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 16.10.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
