Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab.

This Court is of the view that present petition can be disposed of at this stage itself.

Petitioner is an accused facing trial pending before Judicial Magistrate in FIR No. 9 dated 20.1.2011 registered under Sections 413, 420, 468, 471 IPC and subsequently added Section 279, 411 & 120-B IPC (in the challan) at Police Station Shimla Puri, District Ludhiana City. Petitioner was granted concession of regular bail. On 2.4.2019 he applied for exemption from personal appearance by moving an application which was dismissed by the Court and the bail bonds were cancelled and surety bonds were forfeited. The petitioner prays that if one opportunity is given he is ready to surrender before the Court and face trial.

Keeping in view the facts of the present case and without commenting on the merits of the case, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to appear before the Court of Judicial Magistrate

(Trial Court) within a period of 10 days from today and furnish fresh bail and surety bonds of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court. If the petitioner complies with the aforesaid condition, he shall be released on bail. This order is conditional subject to fulfillment of above. Petitioner would also be required to file an affidavit that in future he shall not remain absent unless exemption from personal appearance in advance has been granted.
