MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J. (Oral)

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.76 dated 07.06.2016, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Laddowal, District Ludhiana City.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 16.10.2019, passed the following order:-

“ Contends that petitioner was in custody in some other case on 30.05.2019; thus could not appear before the learned trial Court on that day and that resulted into cancellation of bail in the present case.

Notice of motion for 16.11.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned trial Court forthwith. In case of his doing so, he will be released on interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety

bonds to its satisfaction. ”

In pursuance of previous order dated 16.11.2019, communication has been received from learned trial Court.

The explanation is justified and accepted.

Further transpires that as a matter of fact, petitioner surrendered before learned trial Court on 08.11.2019. The copy of order dated 08.11.2019 is very much annexed with the communication.

Contents that in terms of above order dated 16.10.2019, passed by this Court, petitioner has already joined the proceedings and regularly appearing before learned trial Court.

The aforesaid factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurbej Singh.

In view of above, interim order dated 16.10.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the learned trial Court and will not seek unnecessary adjournments.

The above observations may not be considered as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
