Prayer in the writ petition is for issuance of a writ of mandamus, directing respondent No.1 to consider the candidature of petitioner and permit him to appear in the test for the post of Steno-typist in terms of notification dated 15.01.2019 (Annexure P-2) as well as not to declare the final result till pendency of the instant writ petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner will be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.1 – State of Haryana through Chief Secretary, Government of Haryana, to consider the representation dated 27.09.2019 (Annexure P-8) within a stipulated period.

Without going into the merits and demerits of the claim of the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to direct respondent No.1 – State of Haryana through Chief Secretary, Government of Haryana, to consider the representation dated 27.09.2019 (Annexure P-8) within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and shall pass a speaking order thereon, by affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, failing which respondent No.1 shall be liable to pay costs of ₹25,000/- to the petitioner. This condition of imposing costs is only to prevent petitioner running from pillar to post and avail remedy of contempt in case of non-compliance of directions issued by this Court.

The writ petition stands disposed of with the above direction.
