The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0127 dated 27.09.2019 registered under Section 21/61 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Nangal, District Rupnagar.

The operative part of the order dated 17.10.2019, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, one Rakesh Kumar was arrested by the police and on his disclosure statement, the name of the petitioner has been surfaced. It is further submitted that the petitioner is a licensed Chemist.

Notice of motion for 20.11.2019....”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 17.10.2019, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI

Rakeshvinder Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 17.10.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
